The memorial service for Ruth Triebenbach of Wadena, will be held at a later date.

Ruth, age 63, passed away with family by her side, on September 15, 2022, at her home in Wadena, MN. Knute Nelson Hospice provided support and compassion.

Ruth was born to Elmer and Celia (Pooler) Triebenbach on July 24, 1959, in Browerville, MN. She graduated from Wadena High School and went on to become a Physical Therapy aid at Tri-County Hospital. Having a caring heart, she drove bus and worked alongside the staff and clients at the Development Achievement Center in Sebeka as a training instructor, and parttime with the Pembina and the Oakridge Group Homes in Wadena. In addition, she volunteered with ARC (Association for Retarded Children), buying and wrapping Christmas gifts for clients.
