November 16, 1960 - March 10, 2009

Scott Allen Denny of Kerkhoven, and formerly of Verndale, was born on November 16, 1960 to Dale and Shirley (Schwartz) Denny in Wadena, MN. He passed away, unexpectedly, at the age of 48, on Tuesday, March 10, 2009 in Bartlett Township. Scott was a graduate with the Class of 1979 at the Bertha - Hewitt High School. He was a skilled horseman, managing and training his race horses. His dream was to race "All 4 Shirley", his pacer, named after his mother. During the summer months he would travel to surrounding states giving pony rides to children. His children and grandchildren brought great joy to his life. Scott was preceded in death by his mother, Shirley, in 2004; his grandmother, Bonnie Schwartz; and a nephew, Kyle Denny. He is survived by his companion Barb Knott of Kerkhoven; father, Dale of Verndale; son Tanner of Audubon; daughters, Jamie Denny (Darin) of Clark, SD, JoAnn Denny (Drew) of Merrill, IA, and Jadie Denny (Bernie) of Holland, MN; 8 grandchildren; brothers, Dale (Lori) of Verndale, Duane (Donna) of Atwater, Randy (Lynn) of Grey Eagle, Joey of Hewitt, and Danny of Carlos; sisters Julie (James) Bartylla of Hewitt, Shelly (Troy) Fuller of Evansville, and Kathy (Tom) of Rosemount. Funeral services were held on Saturday, March 14, 2009 at 11:00 AM at St. Ann's Catholic Church in Wadena with Father Donald Wagner officiating.
