He was a farmer and construction worker. Always willing to help you out, Steve was a jack of all trades and could fix/tweak tractors, cars, electrical, and do house remodeling projects. We will remember his love of all things motor sports, whether it be tractors, old muscle cars, ATV's, snowmobiles, race cars, or go karts. He often said, "the boys work hard and they get to play hard", so they had many motorized toys. He rarely missed a go-cart race of Lily's. Steve was interested in and very supportive of all his children and grandchildren's interests.

He was a man of few words, but when Steve spoke you stopped to listen. We will forever miss his talks and words of wisdom. We don't know who was worse at the Minnesota goodbyes, Steve or Angie. 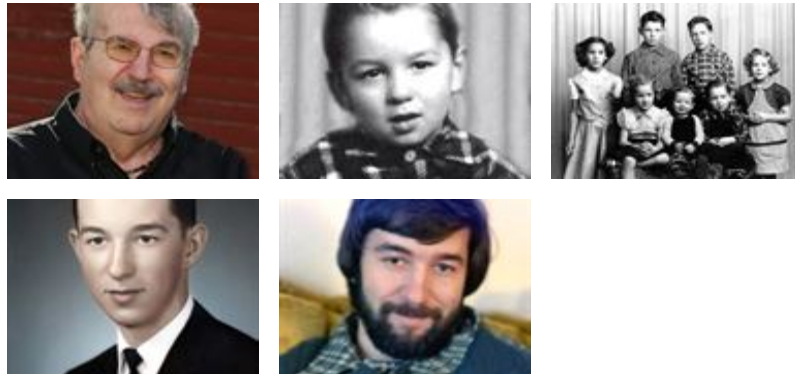

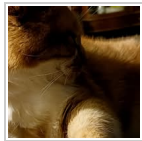
