



Thelma Taylor

January 29, 1913 - January 9, 2008

Funeral services for Thelma L. Taylor were held at 2:00 PM on Saturday, January 12, 2008 at the Faith United Church of Christ in Bertha with Reverend Orville Sauter presiding. Thelma passed away on Wednesday, January 9, 2008 at the Fair Oaks Lodge in Wadena at the age of 94 years. Thelma Laverne Taylor was born on January 29, 1913 in Williams, Hamilton County, Iowa to Jess and Blanch (Adams) Hatfield. The family moved to Hutchinson, MN in 1918. She was united in marriage with Rolland Earl (Pat) Taylor on September 17, 1932 by Reverend Joseph Robinson in Hutchinson. Thelma and Pat moved to Silver Lake in 1945 where he managed a lumber yard. In 1956 they bought a dairy store in New Brighton, MN. They retired in 1973 and moved to a hobby farm at Hewitt. Pat passed away in 1985 and Thelma stayed on the farm until 1995 when she moved into Bertha. Her health led her to move to the Fair Oaks Lodge in 2004. She was a homemaker and factory worker who loved gardening, reading and sewing. Thelma was preceded in death by her husband Rolland (Pat) Taylor; parents Jess and Blanch Hatfield; brothers and sisters Denzel Hatfield, Jess F. (June) Hatfield, Hazel (Hubert) Anglin, Lorna (Merrill) Mielke, Helen (Morris) Musil, 3 infant brothers and 1 infant sister; nieces and nephews Gary Hatfield, Jeffrey Hatfield and Peggy Anglin; grandson Cory Welshan; son-in-law Arnold Sibert; parents-in-law Harry and Alice (Warnke) Taylor; brother-in-law Bill Taylor; and sister-in-law Dorothy Weideman.
