



Thomas E. Johnson

The memorial service celebrating the life of Thomas E. Johnson of Wadena and formerly of Sebeka, will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, March 14, at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Wadena with Pastor Nate Loer presiding. Tom, age 70, passed away of natural causes on March 3, 2024 at his home in Wadena, MN.

Thomas Eugene Johnson was a lifelong resident of Wadena County, MN. He was born on June 18, 1953, at Wesley Hospital in Wadena. As an only child of Allard and Gertrude (Muckala) Johnson, he grew up on the family farm southeast of Bluegrass. He attended a nearby country school and later attended Wadena High School.

When he was young, Tom was a powerful baseball player and enjoyed listening to the MN Twins. As a teen, he was a big Rock & Roll fan and had an extensive record collection. As a young man, Tom began his career as a truck driver for Vernon Mason and in later years for a trucking firm in New York Mills. Tom loved trucking, but had to retire early due to heart problems. He was very social and love to talk to people. With a great memory he could

recall things in great detail. Tom continued to live on the homeplace following his father's death in 1978, and his mother's, in 2009. In later years, he resided at Humphrey Manor in Wadena.

Preceding Tom in death were his parents Allard and Gertrude. Tom is survived by extended family.
