



Tim J. Schmith

April 19, 1951 - October 18, 2016

The funeral service for Tim Schmith, age 65, of Wadena will be held at 10:30 a.m. on Saturday, October 22, 2016 at the St. Ann's Catholic Church in Wadena with Father Aaron Kuhn presiding. Visitation will be held at the Johnson-Schuller Chapel in Wadena on Friday from 5:00 until 8:00 PM and will resume at the church on Saturday from 9:00 a.m. until the time of service. Tim passed away on Tuesday, October 18, 2016, at the St. Cloud Hospital, St. Cloud, MN.

Tim was born to Sylvester "Bud" and Marian (Schloeder) Schmith on April 19, 1951, in Wadena, MN. He graduated from Wadena High School with the Class of 1970 and attended technical college for two years to become a draftsman. Tim worked in the Maintenance Department for the city of Wadena and as a Mechanical Draftsman at a parts manufacturer in Paynesville. He was an avid outdoorsman who loved to fish, hunt ducks, and go after the elusive "trophy buck or no buck at all"! He was a member of the Boy Scouts of America, Wadena Elks Club, and Wadena Deer Hunters Association. Over the years he lived in Sebeka, Wadena, Paynesville, MN, and at Lake Tahoe, NV.

Tim was preceded in death by his father Sylvester; his paternal and maternal grandparents; and his beloved Pomeranian "Pooh-ker".

He is survived by his mother, Marian of Wadena; children Paul, Melissa and

Erica; five grandchildren; brother Bill (Rosalie) of Sebeka; sisters Sue Blaseck of Rancho Mirage, CA, Nancy (Charles) Lee of Paris, IL, Pat (Mike) Schoneman of Spicer, Becky (Steve) Shunk of Virginia Beach, VA, and Michele (Johnny) Lang of Las Cruces, NM; along with a host of friends

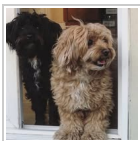

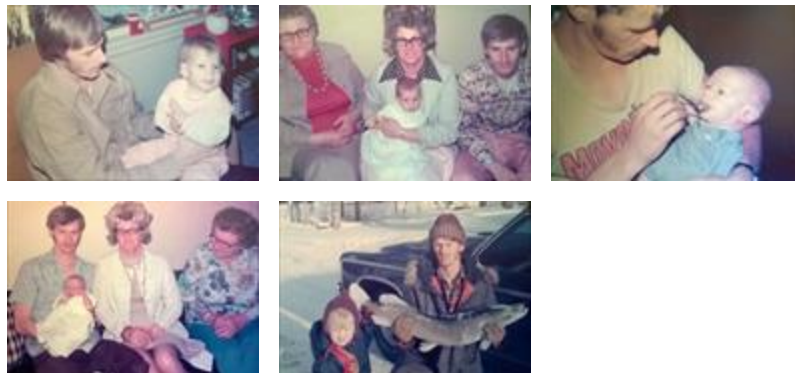

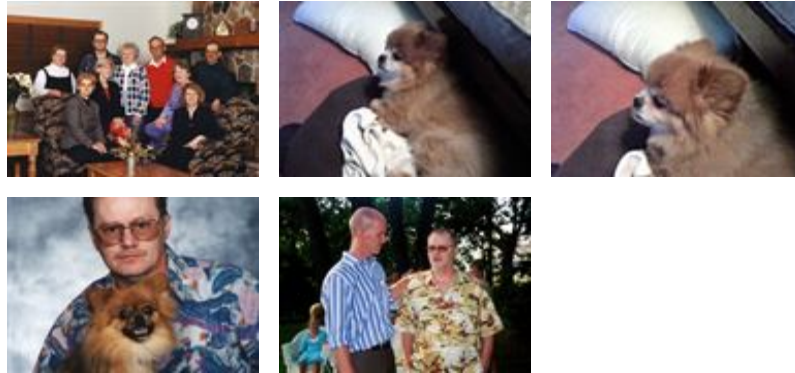

“ Tim was a neighbor when I was growing up and we became great friends. In our early teens we used to help each other get chores done around the house so we could go outside and play. We used to ride our bicycles to town or down to the Leaf river where we dove off the old RR trestle or fished for northerns. We built fish houses in the winter and placed them on the river, later learning that the shifting currents made for unsafe ice and we both fell through the ice a time or two. His dad, Bud, would like to play basketball with us on their driveway. He was four times bigger than us at the time, but that never stopped him from flagrantly fouling our every move. And most every time someone lost control of the ball it would roll down their long sloping driveway all the way down to Hwy. 71. Bud had a duck boat and they bought an old '58 Chevy pick up so we could haul it to Huntersville where a lot of Blue Winded Teal and Mallards met their end. When snowmobiles came on the scene in the mid-60's Tim and I would ride our family's yellow Ski-Doo's all over the neighborhood. We even snuck on the golf course a few time to jump off the snow covered T-Boxes. We got into our share of trouble, too. Like the time we used a rock, a piece of pipe, a board and a firecracker to shoot at and unfortunately hit and cracked the windshield of a poor lady driving by on the highway. We all ran into the woods, but she knew where we lived and we all got grounded for several weeks. (I hope the statue of limitations ran out on these misguided adventures!) We used to build a lot of plastic model airplanes and cars in our early teens. Tim's first car was 1950 Ford Coupe with a flathead V-8. It was a pristine car that had only about 22,000 miles on it. Tim of course had to hot rod it with a hole cut in the floor for a J.C. Whitney stick shift to replace the "three on the tree" standard shift. And he cut a hole in the hood for an air scoop even though the car only had a single barrel carb. And he swapped the large steering wheel which tool up half the interior for a custom chrome 10" version. He tried to do a lot of burnouts but that car only had about 85HP. Now later he bought a '58 Ford Coupe that was already hot rodded with a 430 cu. in. Lincoln V-8 and stick shift. That car would burn rubber for 30' or more no problem! When Tim got his Honda CB-305 motorcycle he was in heaven and rode it all

over. When Tim was diagnosed with Diabetes he didn't watch his diet like he was supposed to. And later on he had to have his leg amputated due to the disease. That never slowed him down much. He was still an avid hunter and rigged up a 4-wheeler with a hand shift so he could ride it most everywhere. One of the last times I saw him he rode it up to my stand while I was deer hunting a few years ago. He filled me in on his health issues and said he had his heart stop several times when he was at the hospital and they had to revive him. He was always a fighter, was always a good friend. We had a lot of laughs together in our youth and I will miss him!
