



## Viola Johnson

December 3, 1919 - November 21, 2006

Viola Johnson passed away November 21, 2006 at the Central Todd County Care Center, Clarissa, MN. Viola Evangeline Woell was born to Joseph J. and Ida (Werner) Woell in Moran Township December 3, 1919. She attended school at District 86 in Moran Township and Edendale #1 in Steel County, North Dakota. As a child she was baptized at the Lutheran Church in Hope, North Dakota by Pastor Riemer.
