



Virginia Malone

December 12, 1941 - October 23, 2015

The Mass of Christian Burial for Virginia Malone of Wadena, will be celebrated at 11:00 a.m. on

Monday, October 26, at St. Ann's Catholic Church in Wadena, with Father Aaron Kuhn as celebrant. Visitation will be held Sunday at the St. Ann's Parish Hall in Wadena from 5:00 to 8:00 p.m. Visitation will resume at the church on Monday from 9:30 a.m. until the time of Mass. At the age of 73, Virginia passed away on Friday, October 23, 2015, at the VA hospital in Fargo, ND.

Virginia Rose Malone was born to Robert and Elizabeth (Spahn) Malone on December 12, 1941, in Leaf River Township, Wadena County, MN. She attended St. Ann's Parochial School where she proudly won 2nd Place in a Spelling Bee Contest! While growing up she worked on the family farm, and in high school she participated in the Girls Athletic Association. Virginia continued her education and became a Licensed Practical Nurse, achieving the highest ranking on the State Nursing Board. She worked as a physician's assistant in the U.S. Navy, serving from 1960 until her honorable discharge in 1961. Virginia filled her hours of leisure with knitting, embroidery, board games, and caring for others. She lived in Bainbridge, MD, Great Lakes, Chicago & Milwaukee, IL, Oakland, CA, Denver, CO, and Minneapolis & Wadena, MN. She was a member of the Women's Catholic Foresters for over 50 years, and the St. Joseph's Society.

Virginia was preceded in death by her parents Robert and Betty Malone; brother Bill Malone; sister-in-law Verna Malone; nephew Tim Tetrault; and niece Amy Malone.

She is survived by her brothers Jim Malone of Harve, MT, Jerry Malone of Surprise, AZ, and Bob Malone of Boulder, CO; sisters Ellen (Elwood) Tetrault of Grand Forks, ND and Donna (Jim) Baumann of Deltona, FL; along with a host of nieces and nephews.

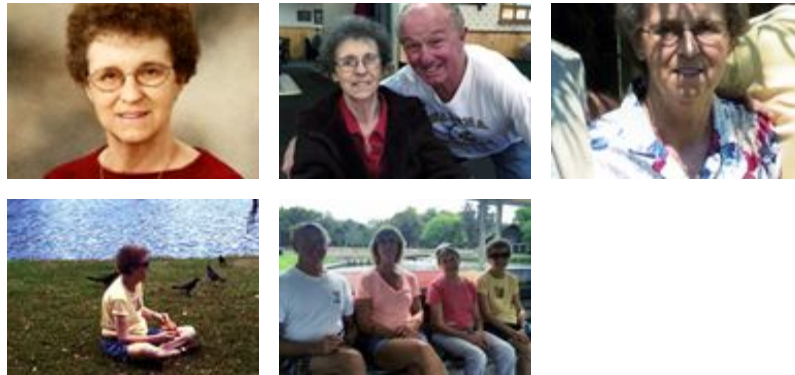
