Virginia, age 99, passed away at The Pines Assisted Living, Staples, MN on February 24, 2025. Care was provided by Lakewood Hospice.

Virginia Eileen Sharp was born to Floyd and Esther (Thomas) Sharp on July 26, 1925, in Compton Township, Otter Tail County, MN. She lived her entire life in the Wadena, Hewitt, and Verndale area.

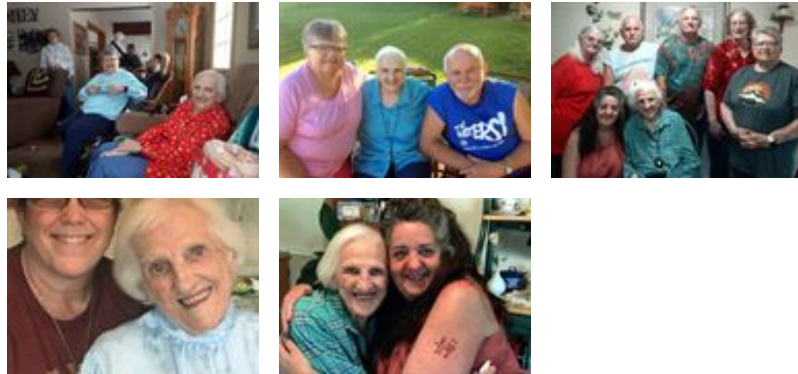

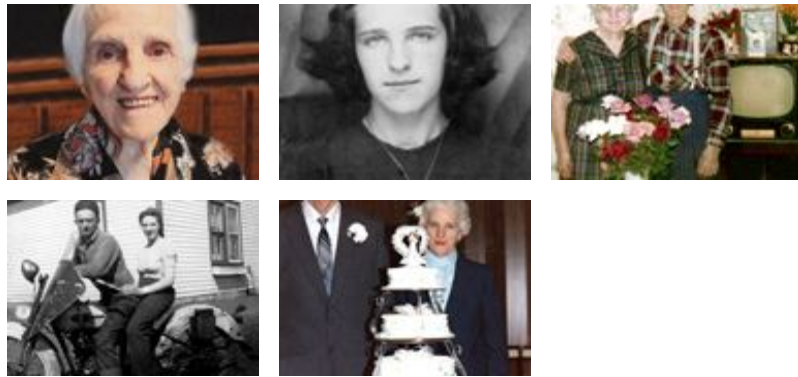
