



Wallace "Wally" Lorin

October 6, 1925 - June 19, 2015

The funeral service for Wallace "Wally" Lorin, age 89, a resident of Fair Oaks Lodge in Wadena, will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, June 25, at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Wadena with Pastor Nate Loer presiding. Friends may call at the church on Thursday from 9:30 a.m. until the time of service. Wally passed away on Friday, June 19, 2015, at the Fair Oaks Lodge in Wadena.

Wallace Gilbert Lorin was born on October 6, 1925, to Emil and Ester (Anderson) Lorin in Compton Township, near Deer Creek, MN. He was baptized and confirmed at Compton Lutheran Church, which later became Messiah Lutheran and was a life-long member. He attended Philo country school through 8th grade and then continued at Wadena High School. Wally started farming at home and stayed there for many years. While farming he took care of his parents and kept active in Church leadership and singing. When he stopped farming he earned his GED and continued at Wadena Technical School, where he ended up working until his retirement. He also enjoyed singing with the Staples Men's Chorus.

Wallace is preceded in death by his parents Emil and Ester Lorin, brother-in-law Thoris Christensen.

He is survived by sisters, Rose Christensen of Ulen, MN and Ruth (Jack)

McGrane of Burnsville, MN and many nieces and nephews.

Interment will be in Compton Lutheran Cemetery, Compton Township, MN.
