



Warren Thomas Boylan

March 3, 1922 - June 7, 2015

The Mass of the Christian Burial for Warren Boylan will be celebrated on Friday, June 12, at 11:00AM, at St. Ann's Catholic Church in Wadena, with Father Aaron Kuhn as celebrant. Friends may call on Thursday at the Johnson-Schuller Chapel from 5:00 until 8:00PM with Parish Prayers and sharing at 6:00PM and a rosary service at 7:00PM. Visitation will continue at the church on Friday, from 9:30AM until time of Mass. Warren passed away on June 7, 2015 at Fair Oaks Lodge under the tender care of Legacy Hospice of Wadena.

Warren Thomas Boylan was born on March 3, 1922, to George Thomas Boylan and Anna Christine (Auel) Boylan on the farm that his grandparents and dad carved out of the woodlands of Bluffton Township, Ottertail County, MN.

Warren was a steward of the land where his family had cleared and built the family homestead. His sister, Evelyn, and brother, Howard, joined the family later. In his youth, he enjoyed his time as a member of 4-H with his siblings. He exhibited sheep at the county fair and geese at the state fair. He enjoyed hunting with his dad and fishing with friends and family. Warren never married but was a respected advisor to his nieces and nephews, who learned family history when they visited the farm and listened to his stories. He was a caretaker for his parents as they aged. He cared for his mother for 10 years

after the death of his dad. He appreciated the neighbors and family who helped him stay in his home for 92 years, until he moved to Fair Oaks Lodge this last year.

Warren was preceded in death by his parents, George and Anna Boylan; his sister Evelyn Dalen; brother-in-law, Sherman Dalen; and his brother, Howard.

He is survived by his sister-in-law, Darlene Boylan; nephews, Gary (Katherine) and Steve (Tracy) Boylan, and Tom (Shari) Dalen; nieces, Deanna (Carlos) Lozano, Debbie (Rod) Mursu, and Jackie (Cal) Smith, Sandra (David) Gould, Jeanne (Gary) Rohr, Susanne Grim, Michelle (Dan) Crocker, LeAnn (Ed) White, Denice (Dennis) Freih and many great nieces & nephews; along with his close friends and caretakers, Larry Edwards, Mike Harrison and Gladys Erickson.
