Wayne Sherman Meyer, age 77, died peacefully on Tuesday, February 26, 2019, at his residence at the Village Green Apartments in Verndale, MN.

Wayne was born to Emmet and Edith (Vange) Meyer on July 1, 1941, and was raised on the family farm in Ogema, MN. He attended country school through the eighth grade and graduated from Waubun High School in 1959. Wayne served in the US Army for several years. After his active duty he worked in St. Paul at Paper Calmenson & Co. By 1971, Wayne moved to Verndale with his sister and brother-in-law to help on their farm. Wayne was a hard-working man and was handy in the shop repairing farm machinery and tractors. He was a Verndale resident for 47 years.

Wayne was preceded in death by his parents, Emmet and Edith; sister Darlene (Gill) Luptak; and sister-in-law Ingrid Meyer.

Surviving Wayne are his brother Leroy Meyer of Renton, WA; sister Lorraine (Ray) Ismil of Verndale; along with nieces, nephews and several other

relatives.
