



Wilhelmina "Willa" Hoffman

March 20, 1930 - February 13, 2021

Willa, age 90, passed away on Saturday, February 13, 2021, at the Perham Living, Perham, MN.

Wilhelmina "Willa" was born to William and Catherine "Katie" (Braith) Macho on March 20, 1930 in North Germany Township, Wadena County, MN. She attended country school Wild Rose Dist. 34 and graduated high school. She continued her studies to become a certified operating room technician and worked at Wesley Hospital and Tri-County Hospital for 33 years, finally retiring in 1995.

She was united in marriage to Leonard J. Hoffman on June 2, 1949, at St. Hubert's Catholic Church in Bluegrass. They were blessed with five children.

After Leonard passed in 1998, Willa married Theodore Ludovissie on October 4, 2000, at St. Ann's Catholic Church in Wadena.

Her family was a very important part of her life, she enjoyed spending as much time with them as possible. She found joy working with flowers in her gardens, fancy work, painting pictures and quilting. Willa liked travelling and spending winters in Mesa, AZ. She was active in her church and community activities.

Preceding Willa in death were her husbands, Leonard Hoffman (9-21-1998) and Theodore Ludovissie (2-21-2011); parents, William and Catherine; sister, Agnes Wilson; step-son, Douglas Ludovissie; sister-in-law Caroline Macho; and brothers-in-law, Francis Wilkowski, Philip Hertel and Ed Opatz.

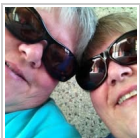
