August 20, 1932 - October 31, 2006

Willard Robert Jasmer, age 74 of Bertha, MN, passed away on Tuesday, October 31, 2006 at the St. Cloud Hospital in St. Cloud, MN. Willard was born on August 20, 1932 to Elmer F. and Emma P. (Lehman) Jasmer in Germana Township near Clarissa, MN. He attended country schools through the 8th grade and then graduated from Clarissa High School. On February 21, 1953, Willard married Neola E. Sjobeck at Esther Lutheran Church of rural Parkers Prairie, MN. On March 12, 1953 he entered military service in the Army. He served as a sergeant in charge of anti-aircraft artillery weapons. He received an honorary discharge on March 11, 1955. Together, Willard and Neola owned and operated a 280 acre dairy farm west of Bertha until the time of his death. Here they raised their four children. He was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Bertha. He served as a board member on Mid-Am Creamery and Dairy Farmers of America. He also served as post commander of his local VFW. He loved farming and was very active on the farm until the time of his death. He especially enjoyed spending time with his children, their spouses and the grandkids. Willard was preceded in death by his parents Elmer and Emma; brother Elroy; and brothers-in-law Roger Sjobeck, Allen "Tim" Temanson and Allen Buhl. He is survived by his wife Neola; son Lon of Bertha; daughters Vicki (Sid) Greenwaldt of Aldrich, MN, Janet (Anthony) Snyder of Wadena, MN and Darlys (Scott) Horn of Verndale, MN; eleven grandchildren; sisters Adeline Temanson of Killdeer, ND and Linda Buhl of Parkers Prairie; brother Elmer "Sonny" (Mel) of North Bend OR; sisters-in-law
